### Combining skills for cost-effective results

#### **COLLABORATION IN PRACTICE**

TEXO Asset Integrity was contracted on a project scope that covered flare tip and flare boom inspections. Our client then extended the team's deployment to make the most of onshore transfers and we worked with them to carry out additional scopes of work originally planned for 2022, so that we could maximise our time onboard.

We worked alongside our colleagues in TEXO DSI, which enabled us to survey the areas in the scope of the project, delivering thermographic imaging on the flare to show up any anomalies. We used a team of experienced offshore non-destructive testing operators and structural inspectors to make sure we delivered a comprehensive solution.



Bringing these two specialisms together makes a big difference to our clients. DSI has expertise in piloting sophisticated drones in challenging environments, collecting the images and data needed to make informed decisions. TEXO Asset Integrity has a team of highly skilled asset inspectors who can analyse the images and recommend and oversee repair work. Then, at the end of the project, our highly trained pilots can survey the area again to show repairs and take images that will act as benchmarks for the next asset inspection cycle."

#### ANY ASSET, NO PROBLEM

This asset survey and inspection service can be used in any project where the initial survey would normally be carried out by rope access, or where traditional access is too unsafe to manage. This includes the interiors of tanks and tunnels where it is vital to get a clear picture of any problems with the structure.





For example, our work at an onshore refinery included an assessment of a problematic tower structure. It's important that the refinery keeps operating, and a traditional inspection would have resulted in expensive downtime.

"Using the drone survey option delivers a whole range of benefits to the asset owners," says Findlay Moir, Operations Director at TEXO Asset Integrity. "Our inspectors get a real-time view of the asset from every angle and that allows them to note the structural and safety issues that need fixing. Using the drones means that we can access the tower without the client having to shut down operations, making the whole process faster and far more cost-effective than a traditional inspection. With this refinery project, for example, we are working with the client on an annual basis to deliver asset inspection and repair."


