

UAS Over Headline Inspection XCS/XCN Circuit Inspection

The Project

As part of a 5 year framework with a utilities provider to deliver UAS Inspection of their transmission networks TEXO were requested to undertake the inspection and evaluation of the XS1/XS2 Circuits.

The project involved the systematic UAS data capture of 105 steel lattice structures. The systematic capture ensured all key components were captured. This enabled detailed inspection reporting to assess the condition and ultimately the resilience of the twin circuit over the coming years with particular attention on the earth bonds due to historic failures.

The solution

TEXO deployed skilled UAS inspection teams to site to undertake detailed surveys of each structure.

The TEXO personnel firstly established land access with all relevant parties via firstly written notification and then followed up with other methods. Once access was secured an OHL inspection team was mobilised to site and completed the capture of all 105 tower in 10 days.

The detailed capture enabled office based inspectors to later inspect and grade 67 key areas on the transmission towers hosted and stored on the cloud based solution TEXZONE which enabled instant actionable evidence to the utilities provider. All data was presented in a matrix table detailing the severity of each of the 67 key areas per asset in a simple scoring system. Sufficient data enabled vegetation encroachment and a ESQC Grading to be undertaken also.





The result

All data was captured with minimal impact to stakeholders and presented electronically via TEXZONE to client to enable them to easily share the results with all relevant personnel.

The ability to capture this data in such a flexible unobtrusive manner ensured full coverage was attained. With the electronic portal offering data to the utilities provider within 24 hours of its capture enabling any critical defects to be immediately acted upon.


The reporting matrix devised covered all the key areas required to ensure the safe and continuous operation of the FB Circuit.

All defects found had instance imagery evidence within TEXZONE to pass to key decision makers and even repair teams with geolocated and cross referenced information available within the one system.

Subsequently reports were generated of the Earth Bonds and some minor analysis was undertaken to assess trends in bond orientation and other factors potentially present.
